 Each IRA owner over age 70½ (as of December 31, 2019) may make a transfer of up to \$100,000 per year to a qualified charity. Beginning in 2020 the mandated distribution is age 72. However, in 2020 only, IRA distributions are optional.

 "All [the clients] were told about the procedure itself was that they would experience slight cramping similar to menstrual cramps, and that was it. They were not told about the development of the baby. They were not told about the pain that the baby would be experiencing or the physical effects or the emotional effects that it would have on them. They had no idea who was going to be there to help them when they fell apart afterwards. They were taken into the room then, and, as I said, there was no counseling done.
