IRA Charitable Rollover

Each IRA owner over age 70½ (as of December 31, 2019) may make a transfer of up to \$100,000 per year to a qualified charity. Beginning in 2020 the mandated distribution is age 72. However, in 2020 only, IRA distributions are optional. IRA charitable rollovers are tax-free and not included in adjusted gross income.
